## WHY STUDY CHINESE?

Chinese is recognised as an important language for young Australians to learn as Australia progresses towards a future of increased trade and engagement with Asia.

Through learning Chinese, students acquire:

- communication skills in the language being learnt
- an intercultural capability, and an understanding of the role of language and culture in communication
- a capability for reflection on language use and language learning.

Learning languages broadens students' horizons in relation to the personal, social, cultural and employment opportunities that an increasingly interconnected and interdependent world presents. Despite its status as a world language, a capability in English only is no longer sufficient. A bilingual or plurilingual capability is the norm in most parts of the world.

Corinda State High School's language program aims to develop the knowledge, understanding and skills to ensure students:

- communicate in the target language
- understand language, culture, and learning and their relationship, and thereby develop an intercultural capability in communication
- understand themselves as communicators.

Students who study Chinese in this program will be very ready for the high school Chinese program offered at Corinda. Corinda's Chinese program allows students to immerse themselves in the language and culture. We offer study tours to China and we often have Chinese visitors in the school. Students studying Chinese have been very successful learners achieving excellent results that have aided their entry into university. Learning a language will improve literacy and numeracy across all subject areas.
