Years 5 and 6	Rehearse and perform music including music they have composed by improvising, sourcing and arranging ideas and making decisions to engage an audience (ACAMUM090)
Years 7 and 8	Develop musical ideas, such as mood, by improvising, combining and manipulating the elements of music (ACAMUM093) Practise and rehearse a variety of music, including Australian music to develop technical and expressive skills (ACAMUM094)
Years 9 and 10	Practise and rehearse to refine a variety of performance repertoire with increasing technical and interpretative skill (ACAMUM101) Evaluate a range of music and compositions to inform and refine their own compositions and performances (ACAMUR104)
