Session 1 70 mins 8.30 – 9.40am	Students will complete a warm up session that aims to improve strength, mobility, flexibility and have them move in new and unique ways.	Room TDA (Dance Studio)
Session 2 70 mins 9.40 – 10.50am	Students will participate in learning a short hip-hop performance piece. This aims to develop student's ability to utilise various movement dynamics and their understanding of syncopated timings and patterns.	Room TDA (Dance Studio)

Session 3 70 mins 11.20 – 12.30pm	Students will begin with a warm up game, followed up by learning a short contemporary phrase of movement. This will act as the starting point for their own phrase of movement that they will create develop through the manipulation of the elements of dance (space, time relationships and dynamics). Session 4 60 mins 1.00 – 2.00pm	Students will once again warm up with a movement game, followed up with revision. This session is aimed at highlighting the importance of practice and introducing them to the rehearsal process. What do students gain from this activity?

Students will participate in a range of workshops targeted at developing an appreciation of the body's ability to move in different ways within different genres in a high school dance studio setting. Students will learn how to properly prepare the body for dance and safe dance methods. They will solve innovative creative problems by exploring contemporary choreography methods and develop technical skills by learning a hip-hop routine for performance.
